Dear Parent

I first want to update you with regards to the current situation.

Primary 1 – 3 pupils:

Pupils in these classes will return to school next Monday the 8th March for face to face teaching for two weeks. **School dinners will be available and the buses are running.**

As things stand they will then be taught remotely the week beginning Monday the 22nd March.

Primary 4 – 7 pupils:

Pupils in these classes will continue with remote learning for the coming weeks. As yet the date for their return to school has not being decided by the Department.

As you are aware dates could change at any time. I will keep you updated over the coming weeks.

Packs:

Next week's work for pupils in **Primary 4 – 7** can be collected this **Friday 5th March** in the dining hall as follow;

Letters N - W	12.30pm – 1.00pm

Pupils in Primary 1 – 3 should bring their completed packs back on Monday 8th March.

Any parent unable to collect packs on Friday may do so on **Monday 8th March** between 9.30am – 11.00am from Sandra in the office

We ask all parents to follow the PHA advice when attending the school. This includes wearing a face covering and social distancing.

If you have any of the symptoms associated with Covid-19 please arrange for someone else to collect your child's pack or contact the relevant class teacher so where possible work may be sent via email.

Alongside this, pupils will be directed to online resources such as Topmarks, Mathletics, Accelerated Reader, BBC etc, which will reinforce learning in particular topics. BBC are also broadcasting educational programmes for pupils each weekday morning.
